Our return to Worship at 10.30 on Sundays

As you already know our first time of worship following lockdown was Sunday 23rd August. For those of us who attended it was certainly rather different to what we were used to..

We had to socially distance—2 metres, wear face masks, avoid any physical contacts. The layout of the worship room was rather different—you may not be able to sit where you always have for the last few years. Indeed a steward may guide you to a place. One way systems will be in operation to avoid people passing each other. There will be no papers or books—the screen will be in use. At present there can be no singing.

These arrangements are designed to keep us all safe and some are mandatory and carry fines if we fail to comply so we do need people to work with them please. Thank you!


CHRISTMAS SHOE BOXES




Holiday Heroes
